Sir,

I am directed by the Postmaster General to acquaint you for the information of the Secretary of State, that in consequence of the closing of the Montevideo - Port Stanley Cable the charge for forwarding from St. Vincent to Port Stanley Colonial Office circular telegrams under the "Colonial West" series will be increased from 1s. 10½d to 2s. 5½d. a word as from the 1st instant. The charge for the transmission of ordinary telegrams between Montevideo and Port Stanley, whether by cable or wireless, is 1s. 2d a word but the reduction by one-half for British Government telegrams does not apply to the wireless transmission.
