L I C E N C E

By virtue of the powers in me vested by Section 9 of  
The Seal Fishery Ordinance, 1899, and by Section 11  
of The Whale Fishery Ordinance, 1908, and by Section  
16 of The Seal Fishery (Dependencies) Ordinance, 1909,  
and by Section 5 of The Wild Animals and Birds  
Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, 1913, I hereby  
authorise

JAMES RICHARD HAMILTON ESQUIRE, M.Sc., F.Z.S.

to kill and take for scientific purposes any whale,  
or Seal (as defined by Section 1 of The Seal Fishery  
(Dependencies) Ordinance, 1909), or any other wild  
animal whatsoever or any bird inhabiting the Colony  
of the Falkland Islands or its Dependencies or the  
waters thereabout.

This Licence shall have effect as from this date and  
shall remain in force until further notice.
