Sir,

With reference to your despatches Nos. 61 and 62 of the 14th May, I have the honour to transmit to you a copy of the Annual Report on the Colony of the Falkland Islands for 1917 as published.

2. I have read Mr Condell's observations on the whaling industry with interest, but it has been thought desirable to edit them before publication. In particular you will observe that paragraphs 24 to 27, 31 and the latter part of paragraph 33 of the original report have been omitted. The subject of the first three of these paragraphs requires elucidation by biological experts, and these paragraphs have been regarded as somewhat too speculative to be retained in a Blue Book Report: while paragraphs 31 and 33 contain opinions which are clearly an infringement of Colonial Regulation 189.
