In 1914 a telegraphic despatch dated the 5th August was received from the Secretary of State informing the late Governor that your right to employ five catchers terminated on the 12th November, 1914, but adding that you had been informed that

while you had no right to a continuance of this privelege after that date, nevertheless the Secretary of State was prepared to allow the arrangement to stand until the 30th September, 1915, subject to the Governor's concurrence, which was immediately given.

- 4. I am to inform you that the Governor is unable to recommend for the favourable consideration of the Secretary of State any further continuance of this arrangement which must be regarded as terminating on the 30th September next. Repertheless His Excellency is not desireus of curtailing your means of carrying on the industry in the waters of the Colony, and I am accordingly to inform you that licences will be issued for not more than five catchers at a rate of \$100 in respect of the first two catchers and \$100 for every additional catcher, the total number of vessels employed by the New Whaling Company not to exceed five.
- 5. I shall be obliged if you will inform me at your early convenience of the number of vessels you desire to employ at New Island and in the maters of the Falkland Islands, giving the names of the vessels in question, when the licences will be issued to your Manager at New Island, on payment of the fees specified in the preceding paragraph.
