1923.

1st December. Proceed Volunteer Rocks, survey Rookery.

- A. If breeding started, attempt to enumerate pups, and harem bulls, noting number of cows (or pups) to each bull.

Kill - spare bulls, half bulls and eight 3 year olds, after killing, destroy all sea lions possible.

- B. If breeding has not started return and revisit about a week later.

14th December. Proceed Elephant Jason Rookery and repeat process, but here 23, 3 year olds may be killed.

1924.

1st January.

Proceed Bird Island and Beauchene Island.

At Bird Island 8-3 year olds may be killed. 6-4, 6 five and 20 wigs.

Beauchene requires inspection.
