Roy Cove is in a somewhat isolated position on the W.F., and I do not consider it would be any convenience for persons residing on other Stations to have to go there for marriage before a Registrar. Fox Bay is about the most convenient place on the W.F., and if any similar applications are received the J.P. residing there could be given a general appointment as Registrar. Mr. J. Innes Wilson J.P. who resides at Fox Bay was formerly Registrar of Marriages and has the advantage of knowing the correct procedure required.

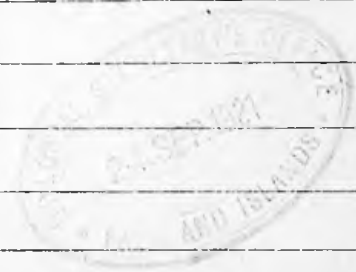
