

BARTLETT FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

William BARTLETT was born 9 August 1824 to William and Priscilla Bartlett. His father's occupation was recorded as labourer, Holywell.

William was married to **Emma JEFFERIES** 27 November 1855. (*not in the Falkland Islands*). Emma was born in 1835 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

William and Emma departed with the Despard party on board the Hydaspes in 1856 bound for the Keppel Island Mission. [Further details in the Dictionary of Falklands Biography online]

William worked on Keppel Island until his retirement to England in 1885.

Emma died 2 June 1906 at 79 Alma Road, Southampton. [Obituary FIM Sep 1906] William died 12 October 1906 in Southampton. [September per FIM Dec 1906; October per family bible]

FIRST GENERATION

Children of William and Emma BARTLETT:

1. **Annie Jemima BARTLETT** born at 7.45pm 28 August 1856 on board the *Hydaspes* at Lat 50.40 S Long 56.56 W and baptised 5 October 1856 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Annie, living on Keppel Island, was married to **Charles FELTON**, sheep farmer on Keppel Island, 20 March 1885 in the Mission Church Keppel Island according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were William Thomas Bartlett and Charles Henry Bartlett. Charles' father was recorded as Henry Felton, sergeant major 2nd Life Guards, and Annie's father was recorded as William Bartlett, farm bailiff. Charles, age 47, died in 1896 in Cabeza del Mar, Patagonia.
2. **Ellen Frances BARTLETT** born 11 November 1858 on Pebble Island and baptised 23 January 1859 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Ellen, age 22 and living on Keppel Island, was married to **Henry Edward "Harry" ADAMS**, age 27 and a labourer on Carcass Island, 20 May 1881 in the Mission Chapel Keppel Island according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Waite H Falkland Islands. The witnesses were Charles Felton and Annie Jemima Bartlett. Henry's father was recorded as Henry Adams, policeman, and Ellen's father was recorded as William Bartlett, bailiff, Keppel Island. Henry had previously worked at San Carlos from 1 June 1875 to 22 April 1876. On 18 December 1886 Henry, foreman of Stanley, bought Crown Grant 31 for £40. On 6 July 1889 Henry, of Stanley, sold the land with buildings for £125. Henry, Ellen and their two children departed 29 October 1891 on board the *Herodot* bound for Sandy Point, Chile. Ellen died 9 August 1897 in Patagonia. Harry and his daughter departed 26 September 1900 on board the *Luistania* bound for England. Henry was in the Sailors Home, Corporation Street, Belfast, Ireland and died before 1904.
3. **William Thomas BARTLETT** born 17 August 1860 on Pebble Island and baptised 20 January 1861 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as farmer. William later worked for the South American Missionary Society and settled in Tierra del Fuego. William married ? Mr & Mrs W Bartlett arrived from the West Coast of South America 13 March 1890 and returned 20 April 1890. William died 15 August 1939 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).
4. **Emma Precilla BARTLETT** born 19 April 1862 on Keppel Island and baptised 21 June 1863 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Emma, age 19 and living on Keppel Island, was married to **Herbert Stanley FELTON**, age 26 and an overseer at Roy Cove, 2 March 1882 in the Mission Chapel Keppel Island according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Waite H Falkland Islands. The witnesses were William Bartlett and Annie Jemima Bartlett. Herbert's father was recorded as Henry Felton, sergeant major Life guards, and Emma's father was recorded as William Bartlett, bailiff, Keppel Island. Herbert moved to Patagonia in the late 1880s to farm. Emma died 3 December 1911 and was buried in Patagonia. Herbert, age 67 and of Killik Aike Norte, Rio Gallegos, died at Santos on board the ss *Almanzora* in October 1922 and his body was taken to Patagonia to be buried with his wife. [FIM Dec 1922]
5. **Charles Henry BARTLETT** born 30 December 1863 on Keppel Island and baptised 5 April 1864 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Charles, age 5 months, died 30 May 1864 on Keppel Island from jaundice and was buried there.
6. **Charles Henry BARTLETT** born 5 June 1865 and baptised 6 June 1865 by Holy Trinity Church. Charles is recorded in the 1881 English census as being age 15 and a builders

apprentice boarding with the Cook family in Weatherall Cottage, Hampstead, London. The head of the family, George Cook, was a master builder employing 12 men and 1 boy. Charles married ? 6 October 1909 (*not in the Falkland Islands*). Charles died 27 June 1943 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

7. **Sarah Martha BARTLETT** born 24 December 1871 on Keppel Island. Her father's occupation was recorded as farmer. Sarah, age 8 months, died 22 August 1872 on Keppel Island from convulsions and was buried there.

SECOND GENERATION

Children of Ellen (2) and Henry ADAMS:

1. **William ADAMS** born 26 December 1884 and baptised **William Henry ADAMS** 4 February 1885 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as seaman. William departed with his family 29 October 1891 on board the *Herodot* bound for Sandy Point, Chile. William was married to **Matilde M GUILAUME** (*not in the Falkland Islands*). Matilde, age 28, died in Rio Galleogs 16 May 1916 in childbirth. William died circa 1918 on board a ship and was buried in Puerto Deseado.
2. **Emma Bartlett ADAMS** born 17 February 1887 and baptised 10 April 1887 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer. Emma departed with her family 29 October 1891 on board the *Herodot* bound for Sandy Point, Chile. Emma and her father departed 26 September 1900 on board the *Luistania* bound for England. Emma stayed with her aunt, Mrs Dempsey, in Belfast, Ireland. Emma was married to ? in 1912. Emma died circa 1960 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

Children of Emma (4) and Herbert FELTON:

1. **Boy FELTON** born 3 January 1883 on Keppel Island. His father's occupation was recorded as overseer. The child, age 19 hours, died 3 January 1883 on Keppel Island from inanition.
2. **Emma Frances Emily FELTON** born 13 December 1886 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. Emma was married to **P HENSTOCK** (*not in Falkland Islands*).
3. **Charles Stanley "Carlos" FELTON** born 1900 at Killik-Aike North, Patagonia.
