KIND FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

William KIND was born? (not in the Falkland Islands).

William was married to Mary Ann GOSS (not in the Falkland Islands).

William, a private in the Royal Marines Light Infantry, and his wife and son, arrived 3 May 1869 on board the *Megeera* as part of a marine detachment.

FIRST GENERATION

Children of William and Mary KIND:

- 1. **Joseph KIND** born circa July 1868 (not in the Falkland Islands). Joseph, age 4 years and 9 months, died 18 April 1873 from measles and was buried in Stanley Cemetery (no grave number recorded).
- 2. **Emma Louisa KIND** born 27 June 1870 in Stanley and baptised 14 August 1870 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as private in Royal Marines Light Infantry.
- 3. **George KIND** born 25 July 1872 in Stanley and baptised 6 October 1872 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as bricklayer and corporal in Royal Marines. George was married to **Harriet LLOYD** (not in the Falkland Islands). In 1911 George was living in Hampshire, England. George, a sergeant in the 26th Field Company, Royal Engineers, died 1 November 1914 in the Ypres Salient, Belgian Flanders. His memorial is on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, West Flanders, Belgium.
