

I, John O'Neill, a British Subject now resident
in the City of Montevideo, Do hereby engage
and bind myself to proceed to the Falkland
Islands in any vessel which may be provided
for me. — During the voyage I will pay every
attention to the care of the men and Horses
which may be shipped, by Her Majesty's Pro-
Consul General, for the Settlement, and after I
arrive there I will place myself under the
entire control of His Excellency, the Lieutenant
Governor, and act in the capacity or situation
of Major-domo or Captain of the Men employ-
ed in Catching Wild Cattle, in which capacity
I do hereby declare that I am in all
respects duly and fully qualified to act,
being myself practically acquainted with
the modes and manner of Catching and

taming Wild Cattle, and I am expert in the
use of the Lasso. — In consideration of what
services, to be duly, honestly and faithfully
performed, I am to receive, by way of
Compensation or Wages, the sum of Eighty
Silver Dollars per month, said wages to
begin and commence from the date of this
agreement. — In addition to the above named
sum of eighty dollars a month, I am to be
allowed Rations of the usual and ordinary
supply of Beef, Biscuit, Flour, Sugar, Tea or
Coffee, Salt and Tobacco, and a House is
provided for me to reside in when not
employed in catching Cattle. — At the termination
of this agreement a free passage back

the River Plate is to be found me. — I
understand, and do hereby agree, that this
Agreement is made for the term and
duration of one year; that is to say it
will terminate and end on the 12th day of
January 1844. —
