

Corporation of the Falkland Islands Company.
May 25th 1855.

Sir,

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of this morning and in reply beg to say that Tiburcio Vera is entitled to a free passage to Montevideo by the Company's vessel and that Felipe Caravallo has obtained a right to a like passage by transfer from José Maria Gonzalez on condition that he should procure a consent from the proper authority to the exchange (so as to liberate the Company from the obligation of sending away Gonzalez) which, Mr. Bailey has this morning informed me, Caravallo has done.

In compliance therefore with His Excellency's desire I will give timely notice to the abovesaid two men of the first vessel that I am able to get away to Montevideo - giving like notice to His Excellency regarding the other two men whom he wishes to send.
