

**Whereas** during the winter of 1844 Richard Clement Moody, Lieutenant Governor, completed the task of relocating the Capital of Her Majesty's Settlement of the Falkland Islands from Anson at Port Louis to a new site on the southern side of Jacksons Harbour, to be named Stanley.

**Although** moderate in terms of distance, only some twenty five miles overland, the problems were immense.

**Now** One Hundred and Fifty Years later to commemorate that epic manoeuvre and the tenacity of those early Colonists, an Excursion has been arranged from Port Louis to Stanley by either foot, horseback, motor, or sea,

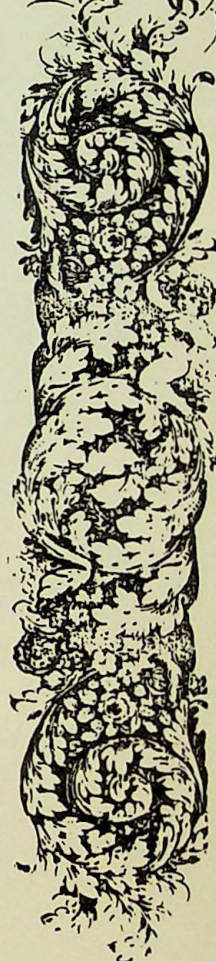
