Sir,

I beg to submit that the following alterations in the accomodation for offficer's in the N.M.C.S. "Afterglow" may be considered.

2 On arrival of the "Afterglow " in this Colory from the United Engdom only such alterations were effected as were considered elsential with economy.

The tennorry Gross bunker being removed, the extra berths and a table with flan wats and a mlate mack being fitted.

3 The officer's of the patrol Vetsel (Hester, Gunner and Engineer are berthed in this accommendation and at all times are victualled on board.

The Government Naturalist is likely to mend a considerable mentod dd time on board and in view of the constant equest for massages by others in the Colonyit would appear desirable that the accommention should be improved and ventilation increased.

5 The following alterations, attached with plan of accomodation would appear to increase the floor space, improve the ventilation and make the accomodation more comportable. FALKLAND ISLANDS.



Intrance to Accomodation.

The companion hatch is, in the square, $2^{*1}\frac{1}{2}$ ' X $2^{*5}\frac{1}{2}$ ''. The entrance to the accoundation is, therefore, shall - the countanion/y way covering the square rises 2^{*6} ' from the deck and runs forward 3^{*} . A sliding top is the means of closing companionway, only drops forward leaving when open an aperture of $1^{*5}\frac{1}{2}$ '' X 2 feet.


It would appear desirable that the companions y be enlarged. The existing companionway removed and replaced by a companionway which would rise from the deck to a height of 5 feet having a permanent fixed back.

By this means acces to the accomodation would be greatly facilitat - ed, and at the ame time, being a complete covering to the square of the hatch, the after doors would not have to be kept closed in ordinary wet wonther and, therefore, Ventilation and Light would greatly improve the accomodation, which at present is very dirk and if the companionway is of necessity closed the ventilation is had.
