I beg to report that the 3 adr Hotckiss gun which was drawn from the O/C of the W/T Station on loan. does not merit purchase from the Admiralty.

Rifling-of gun is worn. At extreme of muzzle and in breech, the Inner tube is badly burred (apparently damaged when gun was plugged on being landed into the R.N. Depot.)

Sights are not available.

Depression arc is incomplete.

Firing lanyard is not complete.

No spare parts, no tools (Extractors etc) Tompkin is not axailable.

No cleaning rods were apparently landed with the gun. The "Afterglow" being fitted with pedestal another pedesta is not required.

I would, therefore, suggest that a new 3 pdr Hotekiss be procured from the Admiralty.


