Before this vessel can be permanently registered as a British Ship it will be necessary for the vessel to be measured and her tonnage ascertained in accordance with the tonnage regulations prescribed by Sect. 6 of the M.S.A. 1894.

2. In previous instances the Harbour Master has carried out the necessary survey to ascertain tonnage. If it is not possible for the Harbour Master to do this perhaps Captain Roberts of the s.s. "Falkland" can be appointed

surveyor for the purpose of ascertaining the vessels tonnage.
Fees for the service, which in the case of the "Belleville" would
amount to about £3, would be payable by the owners of the vessel.
