To The Honourable,


The Colonial Secretary,

I would call your attention to the dangerous and dilapidated condition of the sanitary and water jetties. The cost of repair even were materials and labour available would be heavy. Neither of them are now used nor as far as can be seen are they likely to be.

May authority be given please for their demolition as opportunity arises, the planking so obtained will be used to make access to peat banks for which we have no other material.

I have discussed the matter with the Harbour Master and he fully agrees with the proposal.
