Sir,

I have the honour to revert to an informal conversation about a year ago between His Excellency the Governor, Mr. G. Roberts, Captain Roberts and myself as regards the value of reflector signs in conjunction with a searchlight as aids to navigation.

The view was expressed that if of proved value, Government might possibly consider erecting several around the Islands.

I have now to inform you that we therefore decided to order an experimental sign at our expense (drawing enclosed which please return) which will be erected near Darwin Narrows and a report as to its usefulness made to you in due course.
