concerned as regards the wreck "Samoa" having been stranded near
Spring Point, West Falkland, and after due consideration make the following statement:-

The position of the "Samoa" is such that it is very difficult to discharge her cargo, and she is further in a condition which makes it almost impossible, except with enormous expenses to save the vessel and her cargo, besides the risk being incurred of her opening out if part of the cargo will be taken out of her.

We therefore recommend to the Master to invite tenders for salvage and if such cannot be obtained to sell ship and cargo at Public Auction.
