1. MILITZER,	Captain	German, Blankenese	Drowned 18 August 1891 – buried at Limpet Creek near Lion Point
2. GEORGSON, G	1 st Mate	German, Cappeln	Drowned 18 August 1891 – buried at Limpet Creek near Lion Point
3. DANKER, Paul	2 nd Mate	German, Berlin (born Berlin 22 Feb 1859)	Drowned 18 August 1891 – buried at Limpet Creek near Lion Point
4. GALIMBERTI, Nicholas	Boatswain	Austrian, Trieste	Washed overboard 13 August 1891
5. BROWN, Frank	AB	English, Sunderland	Survived (1)
6. BASSA, Andrea	AB	Austrian, Fiume	Survived (2)
7. ENZINAÜER, Georg	AB	German, Bremen	Survived (3) (also known as Georg WINE)
8. POOLE, Charles A	Steward	English, Jersey	Survived – swam ashore with rope (4)
9. JARVIS, Walter Thomas	OS	American, New Orleans	Survived – age 23 – last mention 14 September 1891
10. OLSEN, Oscar	OS	Norwegian, Christiania	Survived – sent to Montevideo 17 November 1891 on the <i>Theben</i>

- (1) **Frank BROWN** worked for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in the Lafonia area from 26 October 1891-10 May 1892 and received a monthly wage of £6. Frank departed from Stanley 18 May 1892 on board the *Serapis* which was bound for Montevideo.
- (2) **Andrea BASSA** worked for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in the Lafonia area from 3 October 1891-10 May 1892 and received a monthly wage of £5. He took a cash order for £17-7-11 on leaving, being the balance of his account. Andrea departed from Stanley 18 May 1892 on board the *Serapis* which was bound for Montevideo.
- (3) **Georg ENZINAÜER** worked for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in the Lafonia area from 3 October 1891-5 June 1894 and received a monthly wage of £5. Georg departed from Stanley 23 June 1894 on board the *Abydos* which was bound for Punta Arenas.
- (4) **Charles POOLE** worked for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in the Lafonia area from 18 November 1891-22 July 1893 and received a monthly wage of £5. Charles died in mysterious circumstances in 1908.
