Sir,

I have the honour to forward herewith my report on the Whaling Industry of South Georgia for the season ended 31st March, 1919, for the information of His Excellency the Governor.

- 2. During the season under review a total catch of 2476 whales was made, yielding 131,794 barrels of cil including Sperm (vide Schedule B attached), and valued approximately at £700,000, after deducting expenses, though the value given by the Companies is £572,304, which of course is very much underestimated.
- 3. Comparing these figures with the catch of 1917-18, a decrease is shewn of 275 whales, 50,516 barrels of cil and 5% tons of Right whale bone, or a total decrease in valuation of £311,748. The Compania Argentina de Pesca manufactured 5,930 bags of Guanc and Bone meal while the Company manufactured 746 bags.
- 4. The following Statement shews the catch of whales and production for the past four seasons for comparative purposes.

The pccr production is caused by the marked scarcity of Blue whales and the pccr condition of Finners.

Guanc and Bone Meal.

6. Since the cutbreak of war in 1914, very little time has been given to the manufacture of Guanc, except by the Compania Argentina de Pesca who in the meantime had erected a Drier and Guanc Mill and during the bad weather made several trials

produce of 5930 bags. In view of the removal of restrictions after the war, the Stations are getting into working order their Guanc Plants, so that at the beginning of next season they should all be in a position to use every particle of whale matter from the catch of the whalers held in prewar times.

Whale Baleen.

7. During the season only four Right whales were taken, yielding nearly one ton of Baleen, though the return shews only 3/8 of a ton the Tonsberg Company omitted to include this item.

Cbservations.

The ncn success of the season's cutput is of course due to the scarcity of Blue whales; there were plenty of Finners but the quality of this specie, as a rule, is so pccr that it requires about three to equal a Blue whale in crdinary good condition. Humpbacks in number were about the same as last year and though I asked the Companies to refrain from taking them as far as possible, 64 were taken probably on account of the others being so scarce. weather conditions throughout the season were abnormal; for weeks at a time the whale catchers were unable to do any catching, though generally during the stormy weather many whales were seen. The Gunners pronounce the summer to be the worst The month of January was really the saviour of cn record. the season and though weather conditions were bad and much gear was destroyed and lost, a good catch was made. February the Blue whale again left the vicinity and was cnly

taken at about a distance of 70-80 miles off shore. Cccasicnally schools were seen near land but chiefly in bad Labour troubles were rife, each Station in turn being affected. Catching and boiling down was stopped and was the cause of, to a considerable extent, the decrease in the average number of barrels per whale. The two Stations nct sc badly affected were the Argentina de Pesca and Ccean, hence the gccd average cutput per whale cf 56 and 66 If the men were cnly engaged for the season respectively. from Cotober to April as in South Shetlands, I am sure it would have a good effect for the men, knowing that at the end of the season they were free to go home, would work better and give less trcuble. The competition among the different Stations is naturally strong and each tries to keep going as long as possible. Therefore I am of the cpinicn, and I am not alone in this, that if a 'close season' were adopted during the winter months, it would force the Companies to adopt the South Shetland regime of sending the men away after the summer season and at the same time it would give the whales a chance to recover after the insreased number of catchers used since the cutbreak of war. my periodical visits to the Stations I have sounded the feeling of the Managers in this respect and one and all agree that there should be some months taken off each year' say from the middle of May to the 30th September.
