Sir,

I have the honour to forward herewith, for the information of His Excellency the Governor, my report on the whaling industry at Scuth Georgia for the period from 1st. April to 30th. September 1919.

- 2. Four companies operated during the period using in all seven whale catchers, in the month of June and July only 7 whales were taken and these chiefly for fresh food when we take into consideration the number of boats employed with similar weather conditions as last year, the period, on the whole has not been unsuccesful.
- 3. A total catch of 283 whales was made from which was produced 16121 barrels of cil, 3583 bags of Guanc and 700 kilds of Right whale baleen, the whole valued approximately at £82636. The cutput shews a decrease of 4072 barrels against that of the same period 1918, but in 1918 there were 6 companies operating with a greater number of whale catchers. The average production per whale is 56.9 barrels as against 45.0 of the previous year.
- 4. The attached schedules shew in detail the result of the operations for the seaso n, with the addition of the results for the past seasons for comparative purposes.
