
Dear Sir,

We have received from Wm. Brandt's Sons & Co. Ltd., on behalf of Albion Star (South Georgia) Ltd., a payment of £500, being the annual rent due from the 1st October 1965 on their whaling stations at Grytviken and Husbik Harbours, South Georgia Island (£250 each). The sum of £500 was credited to the South Georgia account held in this office on 28th September.

2. We also received from them, through the Colonial Office, a payment of £200 in respect of the licence fees for sealing at South Georgia for the year from 1st October 1965. Messrs. Brandt's state that this is normally paid by Albion Star locally but this year they have no ships at South Georgia. The sum of £200 was credited in the South Georgia account on 8th October.
