



His reason for wishing to enter the Protected Area was to attend Bangour Hospital, Uphall, where he had been previously as a patient. He proceeded to Sea on 9-2-43.

On 7-7-45, KRISTOFFERSEN married Edith May McMurray, 5Ramsay Crescent, Bathgate, - a British subject - and they both took up residence at that address and both were subsequently registered under the Aliens Order, 1920.
