PRECAUTIONS

YOU SHOULD

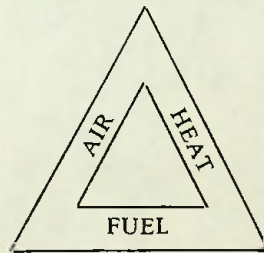
- have at least one suitable extinguisher on your premises.
- know how to use it.
- know your escape routes and keep them clear.
- know the whereabouts of local hydrants and other water sources.
- prevent fires by being careful.
- know how to put fires out if they do occur.

WHAT CAUSES FIRE

FIRE MUST HAVE — fuel (*i.e. something to burn*) — air — heat.

STOPPING FIRES

Combustion is represented
by a triangle —



Take one side away and
the fire dies.

If you deprive it of one element the fire will die.

THAT IS —

- starve it of fuel — this is difficult.
 - smother it and deprive it of air
 - cool it
- } — these are the common methods.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE A FIRE

- get everyone to safety quickly but not in a panic.
- do not stop to collect belongings.
- shut doors and windows if there is time.
- in Stanley call the Fire Brigade or get a neighbour to call it. Tell the Telephone Operator where the fire is.
