I hope in the near future to be able to erect the three new street lamps obtained last year. I beg to suggest that one be placed on Ross Road about half way between the house occupied by Mrs Benney and that owned by Mr V. Biggs: another half way along James Street and the third in Davis Street at the top of Dean Street.

Further that the lamp now in Hebe Street be moved to the corner of Fitzroy Road and Hebe Street.

2. I estimate the cost of erection will be about £10. I should be glad to know if this expenditure may be paid under Maintenance of Street Lamps or under XIX, P.W.E., 9, New Street Lamps, when a Special Warrant would be required.
