With reference to the above it will be necessary to take the 4" diameter pipe line running from Mount William to the Reservoir, Stanley, through the paddock situated to the west of the Reservoir and north of the Improvement Works Depot, as shown on the attached tracing.

2. It is understood that this land is owned by Mr. Bonner of San Carlos, and it is submitted that sanction may be obtained to encroach over this land with the pipe line, which will be approximately 2'.6" in depth.

3. The section of the disturbed ground through the paddock will be filled in and the top sod will be replaced after laying of the pipes.

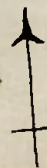
