The usual practice is for the Government Printer to notify the Col. Secretary's Office that the knife is in need of re-grinaing and obtain consent for it to be forwarded to the Crown Agents when it is ally packed and shipped.

The advice letter to the Crown Agents is usually then uespatched from the Col. Secretary's Office without further reference to the Printer.

2. I am to express regret that, through an eversight, no savice was sent to you regarding this knife by the mail which carried the package.


