DRAINAGE OF HOUSES IN DAIRY Paddock.

1. The Board of Health inspected the drainage arrangements of the two houses recently built - by Messrs Rowe at Hutton - in Dairy Paddock. The drains of these houses discharge on to a bank on the west of Moody Street and are most unsatisfactory.

2. The En. Engineer calculates that to build connections for the drains on the west side of Moody Street to the present points of discharge at the edge of the two private properties in question will cost about £10 in either case.

3. Dairy Paddock is the present lowest hillside site and it would appear imperative that something

should be done to provide proper drainage facilities
for houses connected thereto. The liability of the present to
put in a suitable connection to a public drain for the
use of the private lobby does not seem to be open to
question.

4. Suitable connections already exist for the two
other houses - built at building - in Daisy Park and
there are not many other sites in this area to be
sold.

5. Will you approve the necessary work being carried out
at a cost not exceeding £20 as a charge against
Street XVIII "P.O. to connect 1. Roads, Bridges, and Drains" in
which there is money available? The work to be done by
the Ec. Engineer as a minor addition to the Stanley Imp. Scheme.
