At present the drain from the house in question leads into the Church House drain, but the Cathedral authorities are anxious that this should be altered.

2. Perhaps the Colonial Engineer might be asked to report whether the drain from the School is sufficiently large to carry this extra drainage, or whether it would be advisable to construct a new down drain leading direct to the sea.
